

ntop

Installation

A) Enable httpd web server

B) Install ntop dependencies

- 1) Install RRDTool via sbopkg
- 2) Install Graphviz via sbopkg
- 3) Install GeolIP via sbopkg

C) Install and configure ntop

- 1) Add ntop user and group

```
groupadd -g 212 ntop
useradd -u 212 -g ntop ntop
```

- 2) Install ntop via sbopkg
- 3) Make rc.ntop executable

```
chmod 755 /etc/rc.d/rc.ntop
```

- 4) Set ntop admin password

```
/usr/bin/ntop -P /var/lib/ntop -u ntop -A
```

- 5) start ntop

```
/etc/rc.d/rc.ntop start
```

You should be able to browse to <http://ntopmachine:3000> and it should be working.
